

500 Club Rules

Purpose

The purpose of the 500 Club is to raise funds for the registered charity Minchinhampton Centre for the Elderly (Horsfall House)

Rules

1. For a cost of £24 you will be allocated one share for 12 months.
2. A draw will be made quarterly after the end of February, May, August and November.
3. The prizes will total 50% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 27%, 2nd prize of 13% and 3rd prize of 10% of the total quarterly income (prize values will, therefore, rise and fall with the 500 Club's income)
5. The 500 Club is a Small Society Lottery and is open to anyone over the age of 16.
6. There is no limit to the number of shares that can be held by an individual.
7. Payments must be made by standing order or annual cheque.
8. Members' numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
9. The draw shall be made by the Horsfall House PR and Marketing Officer in the presence of a witness.
10. The winning cheque will be posted to the address on your membership application / prize money will be transferred to your bank account within one week of the draw.
11. The winning numbers in each draw will be posted on the Horsfall House website. The winners' names will not be advertised without their agreement.
12. The 500 Club is run by Minchinhampton Centre for the Elderly.
13. In case of any dispute the decision of the Trustees of Minchinhampton Centre for the Elderly is final.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 500 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the charity's funds after 6 months.
